ORDINANCE NO. A-23

May 20, 2013

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:

That the provisions of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Newton, Massachusetts, 2012, as amended, be and are hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Section **Sec. 29-36. Rates, schedule.**, as most recently amended by Ordinance Z-110, dated May 7, 2012:

A. Delete the following provisions of subsection (a) (1) of section 29-36 relative to water rates:

Five dollars and sixty-two cents (\$5.62) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Six dollars and seventy-four cents (\$6.74) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Eight dollars and nine cents (\$8.09) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet

B. Insert the following new provisions, which shall take effect as of July 1, 2013:

Five dollars and eighty-four cents (\$5.84) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Seven dollars (\$7.00) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Eight dollars and forty-one cents (\$8.41) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet

2. In Section **Sec. 29-80. Sewer/Stormwater Use Charge.**, as most recently amended by Ordinance Z-110, dated May 7, 2012:

A. Delete the following provisions of subsection (b)(1)b) of section 29-80 relative to sewer rates:

Eight dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$8.28) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$9.94) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Eleven dollars and ninety-three cents (\$11.93) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet;

B. Insert the following new provisions, which shall take effect as of July 1, 2013:

Eight dollars and sixty cents (\$8.60) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 0 to 20 hundred cubic feet;

Ten dollars and thirty-three cents (\$10.33) per hundred cubic feet for consumption from 21 to 70 hundred cubic feet;

Twelve dollars and forty cents (\$12.40) per hundred cubic feet for consumption above 70 hundred cubic feet;
