

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:


That the Revised Ordinances of Newton, Massachusetts, 2012, as amended, be and are hereby further amended with respect to **Chapter 19 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC\*** as follows:

1. In Sec. 19-141 add to the catch line after the word “**markings**” the words “**or parking barriers.**”
2. In Sec. 19-141 delete in the first paragraph after the word “person” the words “or corporation” and label the paragraph (a)
3. Insert a new paragraph (b) as follows:  
“No person shall place, maintain or display upon any public street or municipal parking lot any unofficial sign, object or barrier to reserve parking for, or to restrict or prevent parking of any motor vehicle unless authorized by the chief of police. The chief of police is hereby empowered to remove every such prohibited sign, object or barrier or cause it to be removed without notice.”
