The meeting was called to order and attendance taken by Clerk Olson. The Clerk called for the election of a temporary presiding officer to conduct the meeting. Councilor-Elect Yates, as the longest continuously serving legislator, was nominated and seconded.

Councilor-Elect Yates called for the Adoption of the Caucus Rules, the motion was made and seconded and the Council voted Unanimously to Accept the Rules.

Councilor-Elect Yates called for nominations for President of the Council.

Councilor-Elect Ciccone nominated Councilor-Elect Scott Lennon to serve as President. The nomination was seconded by Councilor-Elect Gentile.

As there were no further nominations, Councilor-Elect Yates called for the close of nominations and the motion was made and seconded. A motion to Approve Councilor-Elect Lappin as Vice President was Approved by Acclamation.

Councilor-Elect Yates called for nominations for President Emeritus of the Council noting that the individual had to have previously served as President to be considered.

Councilor-Elect Fuller nominated Councilor-Elect R. Lisle Baker to serve as President Emeritus. The nomination was seconded by Councilor-Elect Lappin.

As there were no further nominations, Councilor-Elect Yates called for the close of nominations and the motion was made and seconded. A motion to Approve Councilor-Elect Baker as President Emeritus was Approved by Acclamation.
