A public hearing of the Newton Zoning Board of Appeals will be held virtually via Zoom on Monday, July 31, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. on the following petitions:

1. **#09-22** Northland 160 Charlemont, LLC, requesting a Comprehensive Permit, pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 40B, to construct a nine-story mixed-use development with 410 residential units and approximately 10,689 square feet of ground floor commercial space on 6.98 acres of land located at 160 Charlemont Street and 56 Christina Street in the Mixed Use 1 Zoning District. The proposal includes 103 affordable units and 486 parking stalls.

2. **#06-23** GC Dedham LLC of 564 Dedham Street, Newton, requesting a variance from Sections 3.1.3 and 3.4.3.B of the Newton Zoning Ordinance to reduce the rear setback requirement to 9 feet for an accessory structure. The petitioner constructed an 800 square foot sports court in the rear of the property without the benefit of a permit. The subject property is located at 564 Dedham Street within a Single-Residence 2 (SR-2) zoning district and consists of a 15,315 square foot lot.
